## Junior Naturalist Camp

An Environmental Summer Learning Program  
For children who have completed 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade



Each morning is filled with activities that teach children about the natural world around them.

Insects, forest ecology, creek, mammals, and birds are explored using games and hands-on activities. Children learn to use field guides and they complete simple data sheets every day.

Each child will have a folder to keep their work in. Arts and crafts are themed to our topics.

The games are a lot of fun!

On the first day of camp you will be given the weekly agenda so that you will know what topics we are doing each day. All children should bring a backpack, pencils, erasers, and a water bottle with their name on it. Sunscreen applied before camp is recommended. Shoes that are appropriate for hiking (and socks) are required.

Anyone without appropriate footwear will be sent home.

Camp shirts will be issued the first day of camp. Kids should wear them as much as possible. Campers for Norristown Farm Park will meet at the pavilions and those for Lorimer Park will meet in the classroom (adjacent to the bathrooms). Please be on time for camp and also for pick-up. We'll need to be informed if anyone other than yourself is doing the pick-up and also if your child is not attending on a particular day. Please plan on coming every day. It is not fair to those on the waiting list if you don't.

For **creek day** your child will need to bring a towel and wear sturdy shoes that can get wet (no flip-flops or rain boots). A dry pair of shoes and socks will be needed for when we come out of the creek. If your family owns a pair of binoculars they will be helpful on our birding day. Camp occurs rain or shine, generally, but in case of severe weather we may need to cancel. We will call you if that is the case. If you need to contact us, the park phone numbers are listed below.
