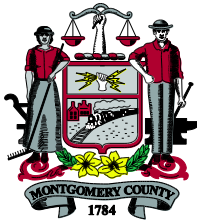

## Renting the Lorimer Park Enclosed Pavilion

Whether you call it the pavilion, cabin, lodge or hut, the stone building at the rear of the picnic area can provide a great gathering place for your group or event. Originally constructed in the 1940's with local stone, the pavilion was rebuilt after being severely damaged by Hurricane Floyd in 1999.



Inside you will find rustic stone and cedar walls, lots of windows, and a huge fireplace. The large front doors slide open to allow more space for larger groups and easy access to the picnic area.



For your convenience there are electric outlets, track lighting, fans, and auxiliary heat. A barbecue grill is just outside the side door. Seating consists of three picnic tables and wall mounted log benches.



As far as capacity, if everyone had to be inside, the building can hold about 40 people comfortably. We suggest that larger groups open the sliding doors to the picnic area and use the pavilion for a central place to put out food and refreshments. A large group may use additional tables outside the pavilion.



Being fully enclosed, the pavilion is available for rental year-round. With the large fireplace and auxiliary heat, it can provide a cozy gathering place even in the middle of winter.



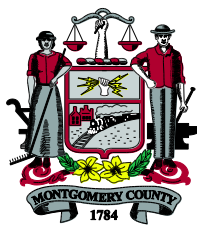
To rent the pavilion, you must first call 215-947-3477, to check for availability. Then, you may come to the park to fill out the rental form and make payment, or print out the form following this page, and mail your payment to the park. We take cash or checks made out to “County of Montgomery.” The fee schedule is attached. Please note: a reservation is not complete until payment is received.

We remind all groups using Lorimer Park that pets are not permitted in the picnic area or activity field, and that alcoholic beverages and smoking are prohibited. Please read all parts of the pavilion permit application.

If you wish to see the pavilion in person, please stop by the park any time and a ranger will be happy to show it to you!

### Procedures and Rules

- A reservation is not complete until the fee is paid. Cash or check made out to "County of Montgomery."
- Major holidays include Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, and Labor Day. Park is closed Thanksgiving, Christmas & New Year's Day.
- The fee is non-refundable no matter what the weather or park condition.
- The permit guarantees exclusive use of the building only, for the time period reserved.
- Upon arriving, the responsible individual will review the building and operations with the ranger.
- Before leaving, that individual will again inspect the building with the ranger.
- Any decorations must be removed, trash disposed properly and floor swept. All lights, fans, and heat must be turned off.
- Any fire remaining in the fireplace will be spread out and left to die.
- Vehicles are not to be taken back to the pavilion.
- Groups reserving for late in the day must vacate the building ½ hour before the park closing time.
- Pets are not permitted in the pavilion or picnic area.
- Moon Bounces, climbing walls, pony rides, and other large play items are NOT permitted.
- Live bands, DJ's, loud electronic produced music, and caterers are NOT permitted.
- Per County rules **alcoholic beverages and smoking are not permitted.**
