

The Pennypack Trail

The Pennypack Trail is a 5.4-mile trail stretching through Rockledge Borough, Abington Township, Lower Moreland Township, and Bryn Athyn Borough. Converted from the old Fox Chase-Newtown Branch line, this trail provides



scenic views of the Pennypack Creek, cliffs, and woodlands of the park. The southern portion of the trail connects to miles of Lorimer Park's internal hiking trails. Long-term connections are

planned to include a connection to Bucks County to the north and Fox Chase Station to the south.

Parking

There are three parking areas for the Pennypack Trail: Moredon Road in Abington Township, which also serves Lorimer Park, Welsh Road Trailhead, and Byberry Road Trailhead.

Restrooms are available in the main day-use area of Lorimer Park, Welsh Road Trailhead and Byberry Road Trailhead.



Trail Rules

- Trail speed limit is 15 mph
- Trail is open dawn to dusk
- No unauthorized motor vehicles are permitted on trail
- Dogs must be leashed
- Owners are responsible for cleaning up all pet waste
- No littering—please practice “Carry In - Carry Out”
- Be courteous of other trail users
- Please obey all *No Trespassing/Private Property* signs
