Montgomery County to Expand Hours at Parking Garage to Accommodate U.S. Open Fans

Norristown, PA (June 12, 2013) – In addition to yesterday’s announcement that Montgomery County’s Cherry Street parking garage in Norristown would be open over the upcoming weekend to accommodate fans going to the U.S. Open, the County Commissioners announced today that they were expanding the hours at the garage for the remainder of the work week.

“We are pleased to announce that the Cherry Street garage will be open today through Sunday from 6:30 a.m. to 10 p.m. for the convenience of our golf fans,” said Josh Shapiro, chair of the board of county commissioners. “With thousands of golf fans taking advantage of SEPTA’s excellent service to Merion Golf Club both on the regional rails and the Norristown High Speed Line, we have significantly expanded the hours of the Cherry Street garage.”

On Tuesday, the commissioners announced that the Cherry Street parking garage, usually closed on weekends, will be open on Saturday and Sunday, June 15 and 16, to accommodate golf fans planning to take the Norristown High Speed Line to the U.S. Open in Ardmore.

The daily parking fee will be \$6 every day. There are entrances to the garage from both Main and Cherry Streets.

The garage is two blocks from the Norristown Transportation Center. Those parking in the garage should walk a block east on Main Street and a block south on Swede Street and they will reach the Transportation Center and the High Speed Line.
