MCHD Montgomery County Community College Drive-Thru Flu Clinic Moved Indoors

Norristown, PA (October 10, 2013) – In light of the weather forecast for this coming Saturday, October 12, 2013, the Montgomery County Health Department's (MCHD) drive-thru influenza clinic at Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) will be moved inside to the Physical Education Center located on the MCCC Blue Bell Campus. The easiest access to the Physical Education Center is off of Cathcart Road. The times will remain the same, 10:00AM – 1:00PM. The shots are free for Montgomery County residents.

The remaining Montgomery County Health Department Influenza Immunization Clinics are listed below. All sites will be open from 10:00AM-1:00PM, except for the Upper Merion Township Building, which will be open from 3:00PM-6:00PM.
