All Hallow's Eve Fall Festival at Pennypacker Mills

Schwenksville, PA (October 15, 2013) – Bring the whole family to Pennypacker Mills on Saturday, October 19, 2013 from 1:00pm to 4:00pm for a free afternoon of fun for all ages. Take a tractor-pulled hayride around the grounds and view the beautiful fall foliage. Watch the kids add their personal touch to their own hand-painted pumpkins, perfect for displaying on the front porch. Bring the camera to capture all the memorable moments as kids make vintage-inspired Halloween crafts, do gravestone rubbings, crank the cider press, and shuck dried corn, just as farmers did in the early 1900s. There will also be bean-bag toss and hay pile to jump in. Refreshments will be served.
