## **Fetter's Mill Road Bridge Re-Opened**

**Norristown, PA (March 11, 2014)** – The Montgomery County Commissioners today announced that the Fetter's Mill Road Bridge, which spans the Pennypack Creek between Lower Moreland and Bryn Athyn has been re-opened after temporary repairs had been finished ahead of schedule.

The bridge was closed last October after a PennDOT inspection. The county sought and received permission from PennDOT to do remedial repairs. Initial projections had the bridge re-opening in April, but a county crew of five worked for three weeks and managed to finish the repairs ahead of schedule.

The re-opened bridge has a weight limit of three tons and will be inspected every six months by PennDOT. County engineering consultants said it was possible that the bridge could be closed again after a subsequent inspection before the planned renovation of the bridge, which is at least two years away.
