Green Lane Park to Host “Attracting and Enjoying Butterflies” Program
Saturday, June 28, 2014

Green Lane, PA (June 18, 2014) – Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park will hold a program entitled “Attracting and Enjoying Butterflies” on Saturday, June 28, 2014 beginning at 1:00pm. Butterflies are among nature’s most colorful and fascinating creatures. Join the staff at Green Lane Park for tips and tricks for attracting a wide variety of butterflies, even in the tiniest of backyards. This program will introduce participants to the best nectar plants and host plants for attracting backyard butterflies in the Delaware Valley. The GLP staff will also offer tips on identifying those backyard butterfly visitors. After an indoor program, participants are welcome to take a brief stroll outside in search of early season butterflies.

This program is suitable for ages 7 through adult, and will meet at the picnic pavilion in the Deep Creek Area of Green Lane Park (2144 Snyder Road, Green Lane, PA 18054).
