Green Lane Park Hosts “Earlybird Walk” Saturday October 4, 2014

Green Lane, PA (September 29, 2014) – Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park will host an “Early Bird Walk” on Saturday, October 4, 2014 beginning at 8:00 a.m. Join the staff at GLP for a close-up look at fall migration in the park. Visit a few local birding hot spots in search of migrant sparrows, warblers, and more.

Green Lane Park was designated as one of 81 “Important Bird Areas” in Pennsylvania by Pennsylvania Audubon in 1996. Take a leisurely morning bird walk and find out what makes the park so special for birds and birdwatchers alike!

The program will meet at the Fly-fishing Area of Green Lane Park. Participants should bring binoculars and wear water-proof boots, as morning dew will make trails wet. This program is suitable for adults and kids ages nine and older.
