All Hallow's Eve Fall Festival at Pennypacker Mills

Schwenksville, PA (October 14, 2014) – With the changing of the seasons, bring the entire family to Pennypacker Mills on Saturday, October 18, 2014 from 1:00pm to 4:00pm and experience a very Victorian All Hallow's Eve Fall Festival.

Just as in the early 1900s when Governor Samuel Pennypacker and his family resided at Pennypacker Mills, kids can help with the shucking of dried corn that would have been used to feed farm animals, shred and press fresh apples to make homemade apple cider, and take a ride around the large meadow in a tractor-pulled hayride which is guaranteed to be both bumpy and fun. Kids can choose their favorite pumpkin and paint it an array of colors or stop by the craft tent and create a fabulous vintage inspired card or ornament. There will also be a hay pile to jump into as well as bean bag tossing. Enjoy refreshments of hot cider, spiced wafers, and very Victorian candy corn. This is a free event. All ages are welcome.
