Many of the park’s resident animals are only active at night, but they leave many “signs and signatures” behind for humans to read. After a brief indoor program, participants will venture outside to search for tracks, scats, and other signs of their wildlife neighbors. This program is suitable for ages 6 through adult, and is offered free of charge.
