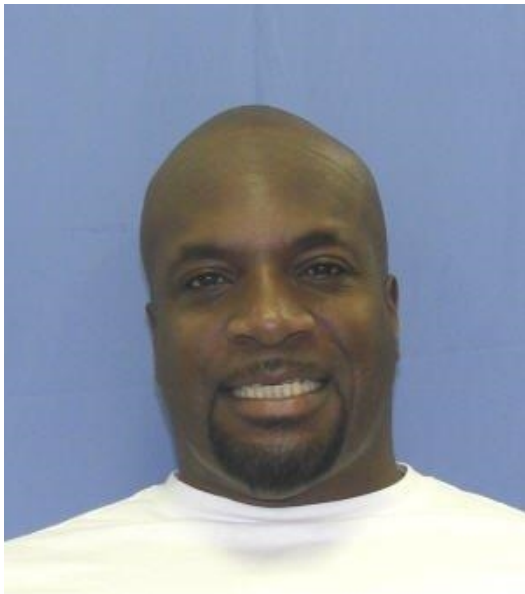

### **Cheltenham Domestic Related Homicide**



Montgomery County District Attorney Risa Vetri Ferman and Cheltenham Township Police Chief John Norris announce the filing of First Degree Murder and related offenses against Stanley W. Laing (aka "Peter Laing"), age 52. The charges were filed following the March 5, 2015, domestic related homicide death of Indra Sheets, age 49.

On Wednesday, March 5, 2015, at 5:21 PM, the Cheltenham Township Police Department was dispatched to a shooting at 220 Sunnybrook Avenue, Cheltenham Township, Pennsylvania. Arriving officers located Indra Sheets inside the residence suffering from two gunshot wounds. She was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Laing is described as a black male, 6'0", muscular build with short gray hair and full beard. He was last seen wearing a red plaid jacket, pants and black boots. Laing was armed with a semi-automatic pistol and should be considered armed and dangerous. Laing fled the scene in a white vehicle, believed to be a Ford Escape, bearing PA registration EPG-4243. The attached photo was taken in 2013.
