Green Lane Park to Host “Early Bird Walk”
Saturday, May 2, 2015 at 8:00am

Green Lane, PA (April 27, 2015) – Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park will host an “Early Bird Walk” on Saturday, May 2, 2015, beginning at 8:00am. The walk will take place near peak time for the migration of warblers, flycatchers, orioles, and many other birds in the forests and fields around the park. Join the staff in a search for these colorful, long-distance migrants as they return from the tropics of Central and South America.

Participants will quickly learn why Green Lane Park was designated as a “Pennsylvania Important Bird Area” in 1996, one of only 81 such areas in the state.

Bring binoculars and meet at Tennis Court Parking Lot in Green Lane Park (2298 Green Lane Road, Green Lane, PA 18054). This is a free program, but pre-registration is required. Please call 215-234-4528 to reserve a space.
