## **Executive Director of Montgomery County Office of Child Day Care Services/Child Care Information Services Appointed to Pennsylvania Child Care Association Board**

**Norristown, PA (August 25, 2015)** – The Pennsylvania Child Care Association (PACCA), a state-wide nonprofit, membership organization whose mission is to give leadership and support the provision of quality early care and education to the children of Pennsylvania, recently announced the appointment of Elizabeth Adeyi to the organization's Board of Directors.

Adeyi is the Executive Director of the Montgomery County Office of Child Day Care Services/Child Care Information Services. Her office administers the Subsidized Child Day Care Program for low-income families, makes resource and referral services available to all residents of Montgomery County, and provides free, drop-in child care to individuals with court related business through the Montgomery County Court Care Program.

“This board appointment is a great honor for Elizabeth and for Montgomery County,” said Josh Shapiro, Chair of the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners. “We have excellent leadership in Montgomery County and it is nice to see that recognized by outside organizations like PACCA.”

PACCA’s members operate over 1,800 center, group, and family child care programs employing nearly 20,000 staff and caring for over 200,000 children aged birth through school-age annually. PACCA’s membership also includes Child Care Information Services (CCIS) who provide county-wide child care resource and referral services. Additionally, Associate members include businesses, consultants, and other entities that provide a service or product to the child care provider community.
