Jazz Alfresco At Green Lane Park: The Barbone Street Jazz Band
Saturday, September 5, 2015 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm

Green Lane, PA (August 31, 2015) – Mark the calendar to enjoy a free concert at Green Lane Park on Saturday, September 5, 2015 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. The spotlight will be on The Barbone Street Jazz Band as they take the stage to play a fusion of Dixieland and swing that will keep toes tapping. The band is pure rhythm and energy.

Clarinetist Steve Barbone will lead one of the Delaware Valley's best-known and hardest-swinging musical groups for an evening of hot Dixieland Jazz. In 1996, recognizing a recharged appreciation for the musical styles he grew up with, Steve Barbone gathered a roster of Philly's best and most experienced Dixieland/swing players to form their red-hot jazz group. Steve Barbone has been playing clarinet for 60 years and has shared the stage with jazz legends Coleman Hawkins, Roy Eldridge, and Yank Lawson.
