Fifth Annual Upper Perkiomen Bird and Wildlife Festival at Green Lane Park
Saturday, September 26, 2015 from 11:00am to 3:00pm

Green Lane, PA (September 21, 2015) – Feathers, fur, and family fun arrive at Montgomery County’s Green Lane Park on Saturday, September 26, 2015 as the park hosts the Fifth Annual Upper Perkiomen Bird and Wildlife Festival from 11:00am to 3:00pm with some exciting special guests.

This year’s event will be headlined by a live animal program presented by the Lehigh Valley Zoo from 1:00pm to 2:00pm. Bring the whole family to meet live animals up close and learn about the important work the zoo does for wildlife conservation and education. Among the critters appearing will be an African Penguin – a first for Green Lane Park!

This popular, community event will again feature environmental exhibitors and vendors, kids’ games and activities, food, live music, free hay rides, and much more. Other festival highlights will include hourly Monarch Butterfly tagging and release demonstrations, and two “bird calling contests” – one for kids and another for adults. Participants are invited to step up to the microphone and let everyone hear their best bird call. The program will also include a repeat visit from the very cool *Pennsylvania Woodmobile*, a dynamic, traveling, walk-through exhibit that focuses on Pennsylvania’s rich forest resources and forest products industry.

The Upper Perkiomen Bird and Wildlife Festival will be held at the Green Lane Park Amphitheater located at 2298 Green Lane Road, Green Lane, PA 18054. This event is free-of-charge and suitable for all ages.
