### **63-YEAR-OLD NORTH WALES WOMAN ARRESTED FOR FIRST-DEGREE MURDER IN THE DEATH OF EX-HUSBAND**



NORRISTOWN, Pa.-- Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and North Wales Borough Acting Police Chief Terry L. Hammerstone announce the arrest of Hsiu-Chin Lin, 63, on charges of first-degree murder and other related charges in the shooting death of her ex-husband, Chien-Kuo Lin, 67, in North Wales Borough.

At 4:08 p.m., police responded to a reported domestic disturbance at 235 S. 6th Street. Arriving officers located 67-year-old Chien-Kuo Lin in the garage of the residence, with an apparent gunshot wound to the chest. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Hsui-Chin Lin was found sitting at the kitchen

table with a .38 caliber revolver in front of her, when she was taken into custody. The homicide is being investigated by the North Wales Borough Police and the Montgomery County Detective Bureau.

“The facts show that the defendant was test firing the gun in the past week and then fired not once but four times, fatally shooting her ex-husband once in the chest,” said Steele.

Hsiu-Chin Lin was arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Robert Sobeck today and was remanded to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility without bail. The preliminary hearing was scheduled for 1 p.m., June 1 before Judge Sobeck.

Assistant District Attorneys Mark Antonacio and Alex MacMaster will be prosecuting the case.
