NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Aug. 27, 2018) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Lower Merion Township Police Superintendent Michael J. McGrath announce the release of surveillance photographs and video related to a person of interest in the Aug 22, 2018 homicide that occurred in the 100 block of Sibley Avenue in the Ardmore section of Lower Merion Township.

The surveillance depicts a male who had contact with the victim during the early morning hours of Wednesday, August 22, 2018. The contact occurred in the area of South Broad and Locust Streets and the surrounding blocks in Philadelphia. The male is also captured on video surrounding the entrance to the SEPTA subway at 15th and Market Streets. The male may have also utilized a ridesharing service from the area of 13th and Locust Streets to Sibley Avenue in Ardmore.

Anyone with information regarding the identity or whereabouts of this male or knowledge of a rideshare transport of this male is asked to contact the Lower Merion Police Department at 610-649-1000 or the Montgomery County Detective Bureau at 610-278-3368.
