**ORDER**

**AND NOW**, this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2018, upon consideration of the Defendant, William H. Cosby, Jr.'s "Post-Sentence Motion to Reconsider and Modify Sentence and For a New Trial In the Interest of Justice," the Commonwealth's response thereto, and following an exhaustive review of the record, the Court has determined that no hearing or argument is required on the issues raised. Pa. R. Crim. P. 720 (B)(2)(b). It is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREEED** that the said Motion is **DENIED**, whereupon, the Defendant is given notice of the following:

- (a) The Defendant has the right to file a direct appeal to the Superior Court of Pennsylvania within thirty (30) days of entry of this Order;
- (b) The Defendant has the right to the assistance of counsel in the preparation of the appeal;
- (c) If the Defendant is indigent, he has the right to appeal *in forma pauperis* (without payment of costs) and to proceed with assigned counsel (without payment of counsel fees);
- (d) The Defendant has a qualified right to petition the Court for bail pending appeal, pursuant to Pa. R. Crim. P. 521(B).


