Norristown, PA (February 4, 2019) – The Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services Office of Drug and Alcohol, through its contracted provider, Be a Part of the Conversation, is hosting free community forums about the opioid crisis.

Shining a Light on the Opioid Crisis is an educational and interactive program and will feature a panel of experts in the addiction treatment field, ethical prescribers, and those who have experienced an addiction to prescription drugs who have also been impacted by this national health crisis.
