DERRICK GOINS ARRESTED FOR FIRST-DEGREE MURDER OF KEITH ROBINSON IN POTTSTOWN ON MARCH 30

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Sept. 20, 2019) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele, Pottstown Borough Police Chief Michael J. Markovich and Upper Pottsgrove Police Chief James Fisher announce the arrest of Derrick Goins, 26, of Pottstown, for the murder of Keith Robinson on March 30, 2019.

Goins was arrested in Upper Pottsgrove by Montgomery County Detectives, Pottstown Police and Upper Pottsgrove Police and charged with First-Degree murder and related charges. He was arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Jay S. Friedenbergh. No bail is available for First-Degree Murder, and he was remanded to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility. A preliminary hearing is scheduled for 9:30 a.m., Oct. 3, 2019, before Magisterial District Judge Scott T. Palladino.

Co-defendants, Kyshan Brinkley, 23; Jacquan Lee, 26; and Ellijah Davis, 18, all of Pottstown, were previously and also charged with First-Degree Murder and related charges.

Pottstown Police found Robinson in his car, dead of multiple gunshot wounds at 10:53 p.m., on Saturday, March 30, 2019. Robinson was shot through the window of his vehicle at the corner of Walnut Street and York Street.

The case will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorneys Kelly Lloyd and Lindsey Mills.
