Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services Announces Free Interfaith Coalition Conference

Norristown, PA – September 24, 2019 – The Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced today that they are partnering with Advocates Against Hunger, Lower Providence Presbyterian Church, and the Montgomery County Foundation, Inc., to bring the Montgomery County Interfaith Coalition Conference on October 10, 2019, to Lower Providence Presbyterian Church, 3050 Ridge Pike, Eagleville, PA from 8 a.m. to noon. This free event is open to anyone who provides community outreach ministry in faith institutions and organizations in Montgomery County.

The mission of the Interfaith Coalition is to create a Health Ministry: Body, Mind, and Spirit for all residents of Montgomery County by building and strengthening partnerships, reducing fear and stigma, and providing information and awareness to those providing community outreach ministry.

Montgomery County Commissioner Chair Valerie A. Arkoosh, MD, MPH will kick-off the conference with opening remarks, followed by a panel discussion featuring “Helping Your Community Outreach Ministry”, a small group discussion facilitated by the Montgomery County HHS Emerging Leaders Program Participants, “Telling the Story” by Sandy Lawrence, and closing comments by Tara Gaudin, HHS Director.

The conference will provide an opportunity to share the needs and issues faith institutions and organizations encounter in their community outreach ministry, to learn about resources and services within Montgomery County, and explore the opportunity to form a County-wide networking group.
