COLLEGEVILLE HOMICIDE VICTIM IDENTIFIED AS ROBERT F. POLLOCK OF SCHWENKSVILLE

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Feb. 18, 2020) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Collegeville Borough Police Chief Bart Bucher today announced that the victim in the Collegeville Borough homicide was Robert F. Pollock, 55, of Schwenksville, Pa.

An autopsy on Pollock's body was performed by the Montgomery County Coroner's Office on Feb. 16, 2020, which determined that the cause of death was multiple gunshot wounds and the manner of death was homicide.

Collegeville Police responded at 11:30 p.m., on Saturday, Feb. 15, 2020, to 67 E. 3rd Avenue for a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located the victim deceased inside the residence. Collegeville Borough Police Department and the Montgomery County Detective Bureau launched a joint homicide investigation. Initial reports indicated that the homicide occurred when the decedent forced his way into the home and was shot by one of the home's occupants. It continues to be an active investigation.
