### **DA OFFERS \$5,000 REWARD FOR INFO LEADING TO ARREST OF SAMIR BENTLEY AND AHMED MOHAMMED, BOTH WANTED FOR FIRST-DEGREE MURDER IN POTTSTOWN**

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Nov. 17, 2021) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Pottstown Police Chief Mick Markovich announce a \$2,500 reward each—\$5,000 total—for information leading to the arrest of Samir Bentley 20, and Ahmed Mohammed, 16, both of Philadelphia. Bentley and Mohammed are wanted to face First-Degree Murder charges for the Oct. 23, 2021 shooting death of Robert Stiles on East High Street in Pottstown.

The murder of Stiles happened on Saturday, Oct. 23, 2021. Pottstown Police were dispatched at 8:26 p.m. to 429 E. High Street. The officer found Stiles lying on the sidewalk suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. He was later pronounced dead at Reading Hospital. A joint homicide investigation was launched by Montgomery County Detectives and Pottstown Police. The homicide was captured on multiple surveillance cameras, which showed that Stiles was being robbed. The video shows the victim was grabbed by Mohammed, who pulls him into an area in front of 429 E. High Street, then Bentley and Dajon Harrison (who is in custody) approach. Harrison pulls a gun from his waistband and hands it to Bentley, who shoots Stiles three times, and he falls to the sidewalk. The three men then run to a dark-colored minivan. The victim can be seen discarding a clear plastic bag, which was recovered and found to contain multiple ounces of marijuana.

“These two defendants went looking for the victim and when they found him, they shot him dead, using a firearm that neither man was legally allowed to possess,” said DA Steele. “This is a chilling murder, and we need to get them off the street and behind bars.”

Bentley is 5-foot, 8-inches tall and weighs approximately 130 pounds. He has brown hair and brown eyes. Mohammed is 5-foot, 3-inches tall and weighs approximately 120 pounds. He has brown hair and brown eyes.

Bentley and Mohammed are considered armed and dangerous. If anyone sees either of them, do not approach them and immediately call 911. Anyone with information on whereabouts should call Pottstown Police at 610-970-6570 or Montgomery County Detectives at 610-226-5553. Anonymous text tips can be submitted using MontcoCrimeTips on the STOPit! app. The STOPit! app can be downloaded for free from the App Store for iPhones or Google Play for Androids, then use code MONTCOPA to get the Montgomery County version of the app.
