EUGENE WARE WANTED FOR FIRST-DEGREE MURDER RELATED TO NOV. 21 HOMICIDE IN NORRISTOWN

NORRISTOWN, Pa. (Nov. 23, 2022) — Montgomery County District Attorney Kevin R. Steele and Norristown Police Chief Derrick Wood announce that an Arrest Warrant for Eugene Ware, 41, of Philadelphia, has been issued on charges of First-Degree Murder, Person Not to Possess a Firearm and other charges related to the Nov. 21, 2022 murder of Tyrone Guy.

Guy was murdered at approximately 10 p.m. on the 900 block of West Main Street. Norristown Police responded to shots fired and found the victim on the sidewalk suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to his lower extremities. Guy later died at Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia. In processing the scene, Norristown detectives recovered three cellphones, including a black iPhone, later identified as belonging to the victim. The iPhone was actively video recording when officers found it. They stopped the recording and preserved the cellphone.

A joint investigation into the homicide by the Montgomery County Detective Bureau and the Norristown Police was launched. Detectives reviewed the video recording on Guy's cellphone, which shows a confrontation between the victim and a black male, who was identified by Norristown detectives as Eugene "Roc" Ware. Ware appears to be

concealing something behind his back, and after exchanging words with the victim, he swings at the cellphone knocking it to the ground. Then gunshots can be heard in the video. The investigation also found that the shooter's black winter jacket, which has a distinctive red-and-white logo on the front, is part of a brand of clothing modeled and sold by Ware online through social media.

Ware is 5-feet, 8-inches tall and weighs approximately 165 pounds. He is to be considered armed and dangerous. Anyone who sees him should call 911. Anyone with information about his whereabouts is asked to call Norristown Police at 610-270-0977 or Montgomery County Detectives at 610-226-5553. Anonymous text tips can be submitted using MontcoCrimeTips on the STOPit! app. The STOPit! app can be downloaded for free from the App Store for iPhones or Google Play for Androids, then use code MONTCOPA to get the Montgomery County version of the app.
