Construction Update

The third phase of the Lafayette Street Extension Project (Barbadoes Avenue to Ford Street) began construction in early spring 2018. It is expected to be completed in the fall of 2020. Here is the latest progress update.

What Was Just Done?

- Public Meeting was held on January 17, 2018. Various members of the public came to meet the key members of the construction team and ask questions. Thank you to everyone who came out.
- Began removing trees and brush along Lafayette Street.
- Utility coordination and test pit excavation for utility coordination is occurring along Lafayette Street.
- Began demolition at the Frieght Station

What's Next?

- Begin installation of storm drainage at the intersection of Lafayette Street and Ford Street.
- Relocation of aerial utilities at the Frieght Station and intersection of Lafayette Street and Ford Street.
- Begin construction at the Frieght Station.
