

Lafayette Street Extension Project

Construction Update

OCTOBER 15, 2019



The third phase of the Lafayette Street Extension Project (Barbadoes Street to Ford Street) began construction in early spring 2018. It is expected to be completed in the fall of 2020. Here is the latest progress update.

What Was Just Done?

- The north side of Lafayette Street between Dekalb Street has been graded for roadway and sidewalk.
- Curb, sidewalk, and driveway aprons continue to be installed.
- Asphalt pavement placement has begun on the north side of Lafayette Street between Dekalb Street and Ford Street.
- PECO Electric continue to perform the duct bank relocation between Barbadoes Street and Dekalb Street.

What's Next?

- Complete asphalt paving on Lafayette Street between Dekalb Street and Ford Street.
- Finish concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons.
- Convert bioretention ponds on the south side of Lafayette Street.
- Complete plantings and landscaping on Lafayette Street between Dekalb Street and Ford Street.
- Open Lafayette Street to the full width between Dekalb Street and Conshohocken Road.
