

Lafayette Street Extension Project

Construction Update

SEPTEMBER 12, 2018



The third phase of the Lafayette Street Extension Project (Barbadoes Street to Ford Street) began construction in early spring 2018. It is expected to be completed in the fall of 2020. Here is the latest progress update.

What Was Just Done?

- Installed a portion of the cast-in-place concrete sections of the Saw Mill Run Culvert
- Backfilling at the Saw Mill Run Culvert was completed
- Installation of the new storm water system continued
- Curb installation and roadway reconstruction continued along Lafayette Street between Barbadoes Street and Dekalb Street
- Terrace walls at Frieght Station were installed
- Began asphalt paving between Franklin St. and Walnut St.

What's Next?

- Continue with roadway construction at the Saw Mill Run Culvert
- Continue with the installation of the storm water system
- Complete the moment slab work between Mill St. and Green St.
- Continue Roadway, Curb and Sidewalk installation adjacent to the MCIU Building and Norristown Transportation Center
