Sheriff's Office deputy will serve on governor's deputy sheriff training board

Norristown, Pa. (April 27, 2018) – Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Dep. Edwin Walker was sworn in on April 27, 2018, at 10:30 a.m., by Court of Common Pleas Judge Todd D. Eisenberg to serve on the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency's Sheriff and Deputy Sheriff Education and Training Board. According to the annual report, the Board has the power to make rules and regulations

encompassing all matters related to the operation of the training program and the certification of sheriffs and deputy sheriffs. The Board operates under the review and approval of PCCD, which provides the requisite administrative structure and staff support.

MCSO Chief Deputy Adam T. Berry recommended Walker for the role in October 2017, due to his extensive training experience and dedication. Walker received his acceptance letter from Governor Tom Wolf last week.

"Ed's passion, exemplary work, and leadership skills made him an obvious choice for this role," said Sheriff Sean P. Kilkenny. "As we learned with the recent Cosby trial, high-level training is critical in keeping the area safe especially under challenging circumstances."

The 10-member Board is composed of two common pleas court judges, two sheriffs, three current or former deputy sheriffs, one educator, one county commissioner and the Pennsylvania Attorney General.

Walker is a 15-year veteran of the MCSO who currently works in the Warrants Division but has served in all divisions of the office. He is also an Emergency Response Team leader, Bike Patrol Unit commander, Defensive Tactics instructor, Active Shooter Response Team instructor, and Less Lethal Weapons instructor.
