Most of all, the MRC will provide you with a sense of pride and accomplishment by serving your community.

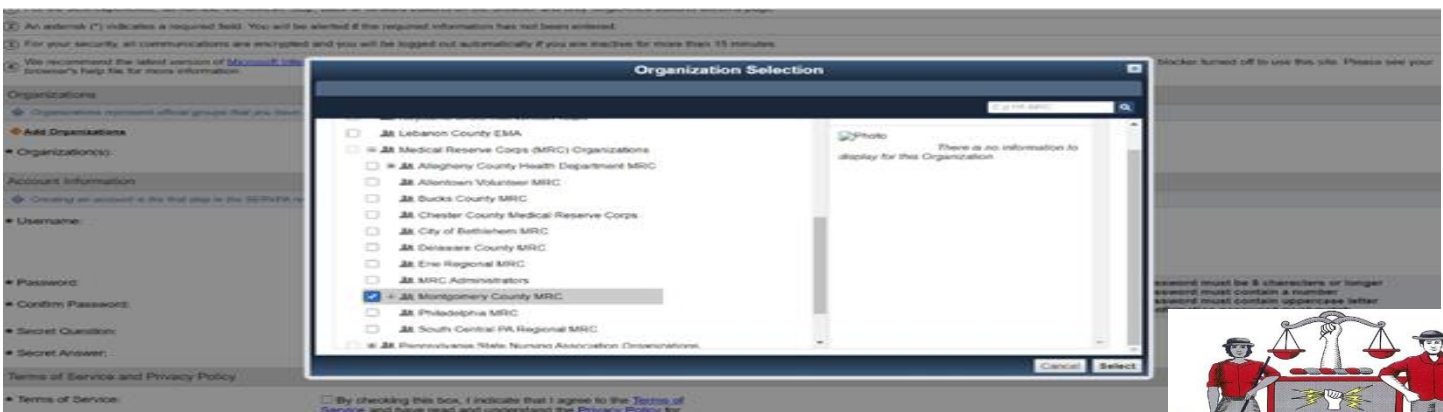
Who should volunteer for the MRC?
