VACCINATE YOUR FAMILY

PRIMARY SERIES

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A BOOSTER?

WHEN SHOULD I GET A BOOSTER?

WHICH BOOSTER?

PFIZER

Everyone 12+ should get a booster dose.

At least 5 months after completing the primary series of Pfizer vaccine.

Adults 18+ can get a booster dose of any COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna preferred).

Children 12-17 should get a Pfizer booster.

MODERNA

Adults 18+ should get a booster dose.

At least 5 months after completing the primary series of Moderna vaccine.

A booster dose of any COVID-19 vaccines. (Moderna or Pfizer preferred)

JOHNSON & JOHNSON

Adults 18+ should get a booster dose.

At least 2 months after completing the primary series of J&J vaccine.

A booster dose of any of the COVID-19 vaccines. (A Pfizer or Moderna vaccine is preferred over a J&J vaccine.)

IF YOU OR YOUR CHILD ARE IMMUNOCOMPROMISED

If you or your child 5+ got two doses of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna) AND you have a moderately or severely weakened immune system, you should get a THIRD primary dose of the same COVID vaccine, 28 or more days later. Everyone 12 years and older should ALSO get a booster dose after completing their primary vaccination series (see above for details).
