- Gardeners – The Farmstead has a traditional Pennsylvania German raised bed kitchen garden waiting for volunteers to help with planting, cultivating and harvesting through the spring and summer seasons.

Opportunities for young people – The Farmstead has an volunteer program for junior high and high school students who would like to actively participate in our special events while learning a skilled craft and about everyday life in colonial days.
