



The Lafayette Street Extension Project

A \$90 million investment in improved access and development opportunities for the Municipality of Norristown and Plymouth Township. Sponsored and implemented by Montgomery County in cooperation with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, and Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission. The project has five phases:

- Phase 1:** Extend Lafayette Street toward Conshohocken Road and Diamond Avenue
Project completed
- Phase 2:** Widen and improve Ridge Pike, Diamond Avenue, and Fairfield Road
Project completed
- Phase 3:** Reconstruct and widen existing Lafayette Street, relocate the Schuylkill River Trail, and create a linear park
Construction late 2017 to late 2020
- Phase 4:** New Interchange with PA Turnpike
Engineering underway by PA Turnpike Commission
- Phase 5:** New Interchange with US-202/Dannehower Bridge
