PERMISSION SLIP - STUDENT WORKER

In accordance with <u>25 P.S. § 2601 *et seq.*</u> of the Election Code students may be appointed to serve as a clerk or machine inspector, regardless of their eligibility to vote in some circumstances. The following provisions apply:

(1) There shall be no more than two students per precinct. (2) The judge of elections shall have direct supervision of the student. (3) The student may be compensated. (4) The student must at the time of the election for which the student shall serve: (i) be at least seventeen (17) years of age; (ii) be a United States citizen and a resident of the county in which he was appointed to serve; (iii) be enrolled in a secondary educational institution with an exemplary academic record as determined by the educational institution; (iv) be approved by the principal or director of the secondary educational institution; and (v) have obtained the consent of their parent or guardian. (6) The student may not serve as a judge of election or majority or minority inspector. I, ______(Student) certify that I am at least 17 years of age, in good standing in my high school curriculum, a United States citizen and resident of Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.
