

Media Parking
Commonwealth v. Kathleen Granahan Kane Preliminary Hearing
Monday, August 24, 2015

The Municipality of Norristown has approved reserved parking for media trucks all day on Monday, August 24, 2015 for the Commonwealth v. Kathleen Granahan Kane Preliminary Hearing. The reserved area is on Swede Street between Airy and Main Streets (both sides of Swede Street will be reserved) directly outside the Courthouse Swede Street entrance in Norristown, PA.

- Signs will be posted early in the morning on Sunday, August 23, 2015 alerting the public that parking will not be available in this area, and the area is reserved for the media for the entire day on Monday, August 24, 2015.
- Barricades will be erected starting at 6:00 AM the morning of Monday, August 24, 2015 reserving the parking for the media.
- Media trucks personnel will need to move the barricades to set up their trucks. Once the media trucks are in place, please keep the barricades as close as possible to the media trucks and do not place the barricades in the street as this would interfere with the traffic flow.

Public parking is available in the Main Street parking garage (located on Main Street across from the Montgomery County Courthouse) and the Cherry Street parking garage (located at the corner of Main and Cherry Streets). Limited metered parking is available with a two hour limit on multiple streets close to the Montgomery County Courthouse.
