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Resources for Food

Montgomery County has a variety of food resource programs to serve its residents. Montgomery County Community Action Development Commission (CADCOM) acts as a resource center for food programs throughout the county, [click here](#) for their comprehensive food resource directory which has information on food cupboards, farmers markets, food stamp program, summer feeding and more. The Montgomery County Personal Navigator Program connects any county resident to government assistance programs, such as food stamps, and community service organizations at no cost. Angel Food Ministries provides low-cost foods for families; there are no eligibility requirements. A box of food which feeds a family of four for one week costs \$30. There are various locations in Montgomery County that manage this program, please visit www.angelfoodministries.com to find a location near you.
